You could be eligible for a discount of up to \$30/month toward your home internet service.



Established by Congress in 2021, the ACP is a now-permanent program, replacing a similar but temporary program launched during the height of the COVID-19 pandemic, then known as the Emergency Broadband Benefit (EBB) Program.



Qualifications to Participate in the ACP

Participation in the program is based on financial need. If any one or more of the following statements apply to you, you are eligible for ACP:

- 1. Your income is at or below 200% of the federal poverty guidelines;
- 2. You already qualify for and participate in programs like Medicaid, Federal Public Housing Assistance, Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP, commonly called Food Stamps), Federal Public Housing Assistance, SSI, WIC, or Lifeline;
- **3.** You already receive benefits under the free and reduced-price school lunch program or the school breakfast program;
- 4. You received a Federal Pell Grant (for higher education) during the current award year;
- **5.** You already participate in Tribal specific programs (e.g., Bureau of Indian Affairs General Assistance, Tribal TANF, etc.)

How to Enroll in the ACP

You must complete the enrollment process on the website linked below. Our team cannot enroll you on your behalf.

Step 1: Visit acpbenefit.org and follow the steps to completing and submitting an application. You can apply online on that website or, if you prefer, print out and mail the completed application.

Step 2: Contact our customer service team to select a plan and have the program's discount applied to your bill.

Remember that both steps are required in order to enroll and receive the discount, so please be sure to complete these two steps.
